Joseph Spark's TSHABALALA: We cannot, on behalf of the Movement, present his application for studies in India. a) It is not properly completed. How do you expect our Movement to sponsor someone who writes that his nationality is Sotho. b) The application lacks certain documentation e.g. medical certificate, photographs, language certificate, academic certificates etc. You will recall that the educational authorities of the Republic of India insist on properly completed forms accompanied by educational certificates. Why do you not send him to SCHAFCO? It is only from there that he can get some form of assessment and thus certification. We are enclosing herein Ishabalala's application forms. we hope that you will very soon oblige us with the documents which were inadvertently omitted in Patricia's application. We, finally, propose that you present Tshabalala's application at the High Commission of India there in Lusaka.

We hope to hear from you soon. Otherwise we together with SCMAFCC are proceeding with selections for placements. We will keep in touch.
