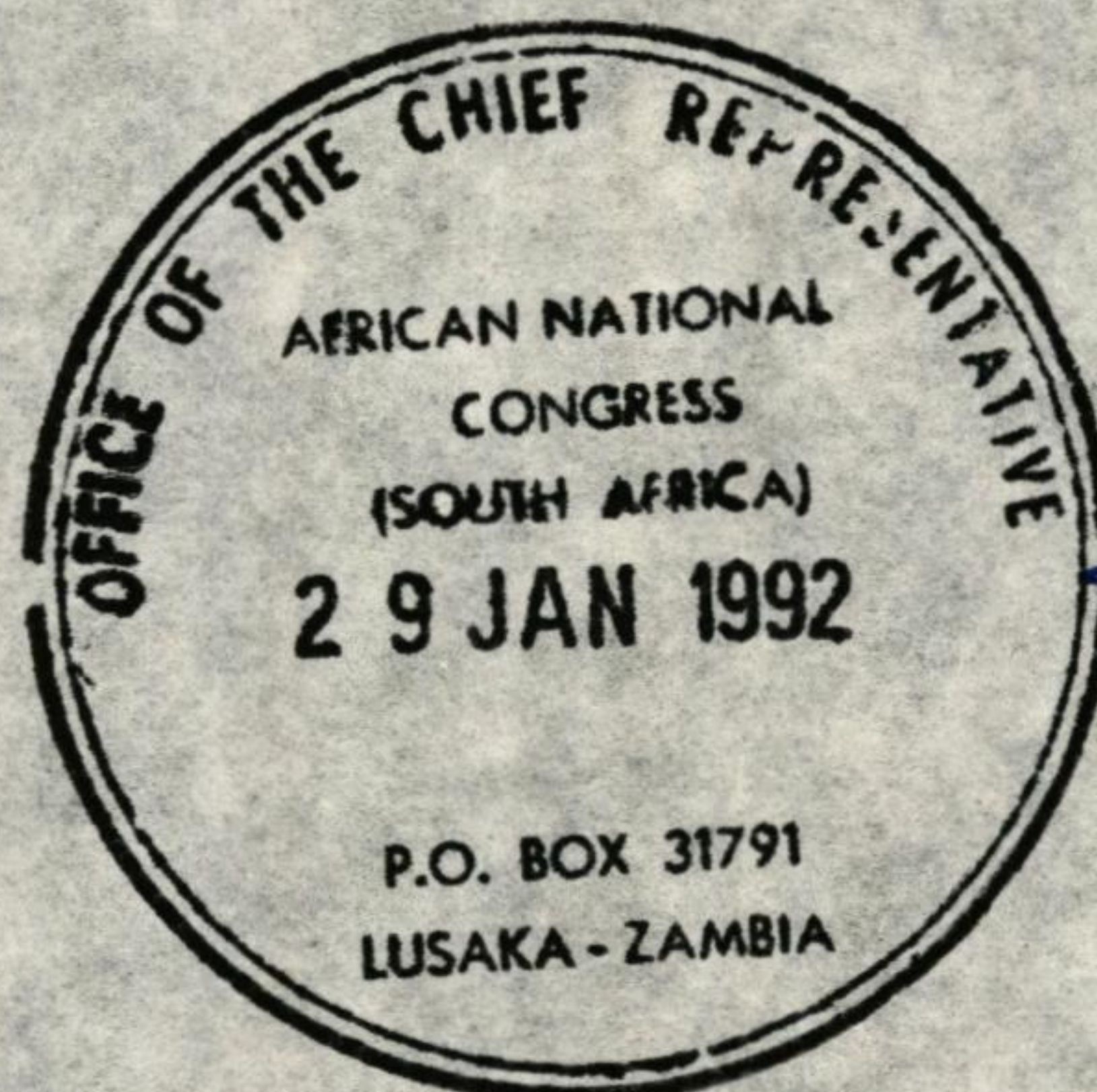
It would, therefore, be highly appreciated Sir, if UNESCO could offer a fellowship to Cde Makhetha to enable him to complete his studies without hinderance.


If this application meets your favourable reply, this office shall accordingly inform the Luthuli Foundation.
