for Bethuel SIWELE to travel to Maputo and you should arrange his
clearance accordingly, and explain to the Chief Representative there
what his mission is and how long he expects to be in Maputo.
It is not necessary for me to address the question of expcass of travel
in view of the concluding paragraph of your letter.
