

This is a follow-up to my memo of 29th October regarding the general accommodation of staff. Jerry says in her memo of 24 Oct to me:

"As you are well aware, I work in the school office at SOMAFCO from 8 am to 4 pm; in addition, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, I teach for Adult Education from 4:30 pm. As you can imagine, by the time I arrive home at 6:30 pm, I am quite exhausted and need to relax in a quiet atmosphere; however, this is impossible in Tabora due to the volume of noise that emanates from the neighbourhood. More importantly, I find it impossible to study and prepare for my lessons."

As strongly emphasised by Comrade Henry and in my earlier views to you on the question of staff housing, I once more appeal that the allocation of staff houses must be done by you in consultation with the Education Committee.
