1. ANC has closed all its Centres in Tanzania.
2. ANC Personnel still in Tanzania lives on a meagre monthly subsistence allowance from which they can pay for their accommodation and food.
3. All ANC students, therefore, wholly depend for their survival on their stipends from their supporting scholarship sponsors.
4. Most of them live in private accommodation and have to travel to school every morning. Now they don't have any money for transport or food.
5. Those in Primary and Secondary Schools are also being expelled in Tanzania, Swaziland, Zimbabwe and Lesotho.

Could something be done to assist and rescue the situation.

6. The ANC leader paid glowing tribute to the Tanzanian people who allocated land to the ANC and for allowing them to operate autonomously to foster self reliance in educating and training ANC cadres who will be highly useful in the post apartheid South Africa.

7. The ANC delegation delivered a message from the ANC National Executive Committee to CCM and a letter from the President of the ANC Comrade Nelson Mandela to the CCM Chairman Ndugu Ali Hassan Mwinyi. In this message the ANC conveyed its decision to hand over the ANC facilities in Mazimbu and Dakawa in Morogoro to the Party authorities and people of Tanzania. The ANC delegation called for discussion of modalities for the said handover.

8. The CCM delegation expressed appreciation and gratification for the ANC's generous gesture. The CCM delegation considered the ANC decision as an act of great consideration and that the facilities will be properly used and well kept as a fitting symbol of the historic relations between CCM and the ANC.

9. After discussion of the issue of handing over of the ANC facilities at Mazimbu and Dakawa the two delegations agreed jointly as follows:
