- 1. ANC has closed all its Centres in Tanzania.
- 2. ANC Personnel still in Tanzania lives on a meagre monthly subsistence allowance from which they can pay for their accommodation and food.
- 3. All ANC students, therefore, wholly depend for their survival on their stipends from their supporting scholarship sponsors.
- 4. Most of them live in private accommodation and have to travel to school every morning. Now they don't have any money for transport or food.
- 5. Those in Primary and Secondary Schools are also being expelled in Tanzania, Swaziland, Zimbabwe and Lesotho.

  Could something be done to assist and rescue the situation.
