COMMISSION ON EDUCATION hND TRAIHING Commission discussed mainly structure and the educational establishments in Dakawa. Structure was discussed as a means of channelling of human resources - it was looked at in terms of the proposed autonomy of the place. STRUCTURE

A Director of Schools has been appeinted end he will be based in Mazimbu. Commission recommends the appointment of an Assistant Director who will be bLeed in Dakawa. His job should be to lo); afteiaghetinterests of the educetional institutions in Dakawa. He will be responsible to the Director of Schools who in turn will be responsible to Headquarters. This arlangment is in accordance with the the decision'that the Jducation-Department will be responsible for all educational activities of the ANC. The Assistant Director should work 0E3,a way of working with the Dukawa Town Council, engage should also establish a committee within which h% will work.

_Each eduCgtional establisgment should have a committee to run its affairs. The Assistant Director should be in touch with the committees and Work With the establishment through them. The different establishments should co-ordinate their activities on a consultative basis

It was generally agreed that the rural skills programme belongs to Adult Education but it was also recognised that the VTC played a major role in managinthhe pregraume. It was recommended that there should be a roe towards joint management by Adult Education and VTC. The programme has had 3 stages of runling, first stage was in Turin, the second in Harare and now it has reached a planning stige.

The Health team has been incorporated as the programme is seen as a possible rehabilitation programme for our

mentally-ill comrade"

SERVICES

Commission noted that Dakawa is in need of essential services includinggg.library services. Finnida has -pnomiaed to assist in this area. There is a suggestion for a mobile library to service the Whole of Dakawa. At the mouent the library here is_a branch of the SOMAECQ one. Commission recommends the estehlishment of a community library and resource centree to minister to the special needs of eVery educational establishment. The ordering of specialised teaching material should be left in the hands of the teecher concerned. A Bursar for schools should be apgointed and she/he should be responsible to the Director of Schools.

EOC

The Centre is envisaged as incoperating

- 1. Academic upgrading
- 2. Political Orientation
- 3. Teacher inrservice

The aeaaemic upgrading will be headed by a prinicipal; political orientation-Will be the responsibility of the DPE and the invservice teacher training will support SOMAF. It is expected that there will be a management structure to ran the affairs of the ECG. ngbdxweGhCTVwax Cbxhcevewehaa CaxAtvgj

It was suggested that the working of NAT in the E00 should be inconspicuous and subtle. In resgonse it was suggested that RhT should be allocated a reception area. It was left up to senior comrades of NnT and zducatiun to work out a working relationship.

Transgort for the DCC should be grovided and a massive training scheme for personnel should be embarked upon, There should be co-ordiantion between the women's Section 'and the Education Degartnent on the running of the DCC. DCC personnel should be uygraded.
