TIT IS CONFIRMED THAT STATE PRESIDENT F.W. DE KLERK...WILL MAKE A ONE-DAY VISIT TO ZAIRE. . IN ORDER TO ATTEND A MEETING OF A NUMBER OF AFRICAN HEADS OF STATES THE PRESIDENT'S SPOKESMAN SAID IN A STATEMENT ON MONDAY. THE MEETING WAS SET FOR SATURDAY. IT WILL BE THE FIRST TIME A SOUTH AFRICAN HEAD OF GOVERNMENT A GROUP OF AFRICAN LEADERS SINCE THE RULING WHITE NATIONAL PARTY CAME TO POWER IN 1948. MANDELA, MEANWHILE, PREPARED FOR A ROUND OF INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL TO LOBBY FOR SUPPORT AND SAID HE WANTED TO DISCUSS SANCTIONS WITH BRITISH FRIME MINISTER MARGARET THATCHER. THE AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS (ANC) LEADER TOLD BRITAIN'S TV-AM NEWS HE HAD A SUGGESTION FOR THATCHER, WHO WANTS TO LIFT SOME SANCTIONS TO ENCOURAGE PRETORIA, BUT GAVE NO DETAILS. HMY INTENTION IS TO PHONE AND SPEAK TO THE BRITISH PREMIER ON THIS QUESTION. WE REGARD THE ATTITUDE OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT ON THE QUESTION OF SANCTIONS AS OF PRIMARY IMPORTANCE: + SAID MANDELA: WHO WANTS SANCTIONS TO REMAIN. +I HAVE A SUGGESTION TO MAKE AND IF I GET CLEARANCE FROM THE CANCO NATIONAL EXECUTIVE I WILL DO THAT IMMEDIATELY, - HE SAID. BRITAIN HAS SAID IT MAY ACT ALONE ON EASING SOME SANCTIONS IF, AS EXPECTED, IT MEETS STRONG OPPOSITION TO A RELAXATION AT A MEETING OF EUROPEAN COMMUNITY MINISTERS IN DUBLIN ON TUESDAY. POLITICAL AMALYSTS SAID THE INVITATION TO DE KLERK TO ATTEND THE ZAIRE MEETING APPEARED TO BE THE FIRST AFRICAN DIPLOMATIC REWARD FOR HIS FEBRUARY 2 DECISIONS TO LIFT THE BAN ON THE ANC AND OTHER POLITICAL ORGANISATIONS AND RELEASE MANDELA. GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS SAID IT WAS NOT KNOWN WHICH AFRICAN HEADS OF STATE WOULD ATTEND THE MEETING. BUT GOVERNMENT SOURCES SAID IT WOULD BE CHAIRED BY ZAIREAN PRESIDENT MOBUTU SESE SEKO. THEY SAID MOBUTU'S INVITATION TO DE KLERK COULD BE BEEN AS A REWARD FOR PRETORIA'S RECENT EFFORTS TO BREAK THE LOGIAM IN SOUTH AFRICAN FOLITICS AND MOVE AWAY FROM RACIAL DISCRIMINATION. SOUTH AFRICA HAS BEEN INCREASINGLY ISOLATED INTERNATIONALLY OVER THE PAST DECADE AND WAS PARTICULARLY SHUNNED BY ITS BLACK AFRICAN NEIGHBOURS. NOW DE KLERK'S INITIATIVES HAVE BEGUN TO REAP REWARDS. BRITISH FRIME MINISTER MARGARET THATCHER HAS INVITED HIM TO LONDON AND U.S. PRESIDENT GEORGE BUSH HAS INDICATED HE COULD SOON BE WELCOME IN WASHINGTON. DE KLERK HAS MET ZAMBIAN PRESIDENT KENNETH KAUNDA, MOZAMBICAN PRESIDENT JOAQUIM CHISSANO AND PRESIDENT FELIX HOUPHOUET-BOIGNY OF THE IVORY COAST SINCE FORCING HIS PREDECESSOR P.W. BOTHA FROM OFFICE LAST YEAR. BOTHA MET MOBUTU LAST YEAR, BUT SOURCES IN HIS OFFICE SAID HE NEVER ACHIEVED HIS LONG-STANDING AMBITION OF ATTENDING A SUMMIT OF AFRICAN LEADERS. THE SOUTH AFRICAN HOME AFFAIRS MINISTRY, MEANWHILE, SAID IT HAD APPROVED PASSPORT APPLICATIONS FOR MANDELA AND HIS WIFE WINNIE AND WOULD PROBABLY ISSUE THE DOCUMENTS LATER ON MONDAY. MANDELA HAS SAID HE WILL TRAVEL TO AND HEADQUARTERS IN EXILE IN LUBAKA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO DISCUSS POLICY WITH THE LONG-OUTLAWED MOVEMENT'S LEADERSHIP-IN-EXILE AND TO WORK OUT HIS EXACT ROLE IN THE ORGANISATION. ANC LEADERS IN LUSAKA HAVE GIVEN THE TASK OF RESTRUCTURING THE ORGANISATION WITHIN SOUTH AFRICA TO MANDELA'S COLLEAGUE WALTER SISULU, ONE OF SEVEN AND VETERANS FREED IN OCTOBER. THE ANC WAS LEGALISED ON FEBRUARY 2 AND MUST NOW TRANSFORM ITSELF FROM A SECRETIVE UNDERGROUND GUERRILLA ORGANISATION INTO AN OPEN POLITICAL PARTY. REUTER ASB SB JC NN NN

JOHANNESBURG, FEB 20, REUTER - PRESIDENT F.W. DE KLERK HAS ANNOUNCED AN UNPRECEDENTED SUMMIT WITH BLACK AFRICAN HEADS OF STATE ON SATURDAY IN AN APPARENT BREAKTHROUGH FOR SOUTH AFRICA'S EFFORTS TO WIN FRIENDS ON THE CONTINENT.

THE MEETING IN ZAIRE, ANNOUNCED BY DE KLERK'S OFFICE ON MONDAY, WOULD BE THE FIRST TIME INDEPENDENT AFRICAN STATES HAVE ALLOWED A SOUTH AFRICAN LEADER TO ATTEND ONE OF THEIR SUMMITS.

POLITICAL ANALYSTS SAID DE KLERK HAD BEEN INVITED TO THE TALKS LARGELY IN RECOGNITION OF HIS RELEASING AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS (ANC) FIGUREHEAD NELSON MANDELA NINE DAYS AGO.

MANDELA'S FREEDOM HAD BEEN THE MAIN OBSTACLE TO DIPLOMATIC LINKS WITH THE LAND OF APARTHEID FOR ZAIRE AND OTHER MODERATE AFRICAN STATES LIKE IVORY COAST AND GABON.

+DE KLERK IS TRYING TO CASH IN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE ON MANDELA, TO PUT PRESSURE ON THE ANC, + SAID RICHARD CORNWELL, AN ANALYST WITH THE PRETORIA-BACKED AFRICA INSTITUTE.

THE ANALYSTS SAID ATTEMPTS TO FORGE A CEASEFIRE IN THE ANGOLAN CIVIL WAR AND THE FAST-MOVING POLITICAL DEVELOPMENTS IN SOUTH AFRICA WOULD DOMINATE THE ONE-DAY MEETING.

GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS SAID DE KLERK WOULD MEET A NUMBER OF HEADS OF STATE; BUT DID NOT IDENTIFY THEM.

THE ANALYSTS SAID GABON, ZAMBIA, IVORY COAST AND MALAWI WERE PROBABLE PARTICIPANTS IN THE TALKS.

GABONESE PRESIDENT OMAR BONGO HAS URGED BLACK AFRICAN COUNTRIES TO ESTABLISH DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH SOUTH AFRICA BECAUSE OF MANDELA'S RELEASE. ZAIREAN OFFICIALS HAVE SAID MANDELA'S RELEASE OPENS THE WAY FOR A WIDER DIALOGUE.

PRETORIA HAS SOUGHT DIPLOMATIC RECOGNITION AND A LARGER EXPORT MARKET IN BLACK AFRICA FOR DECADES BUT HAS BEEN SHUNNED BY MOST OF THE CONTINENT BECAUSE OF ITS APARTHEID RACE POLICIES AND ITS IMPRISONMENT OF BLACK LEADERS LIKE MANDELA.

CORNWELL SAID DE KLERK'S MEETING WITH SEVERAL COUNTRIES THAT HAVE BACKED THE ANC WOULD PUT PRESSURE ON THE NEWLY LEGALISED GROUP -- THE MAIN ORGANISATION FIGHTING WHITE RULE -- TO START NEGOTIATIONS WITH PRETORIA ON A POLITICAL SETTLEMENT.

GOVERNMENT SOURCES SAID THE TALKS WOULD BE CHAIRED BY ZAIREAN PRESIDENT MOBUTU SESE SEKO BUT WOULD NOT BE RESTRICTED TO HIS EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE A CHASEFIRE IN ANGOLA.

THEY WILL WANT INFORMATION FROM DE KLERK ABOUT HIS FUTURE PLANS AND DIRECT EVIDENCE THAT HE WILL CONTINUE WITH REFORMS. SAID AFRICA INSTITUTE HISTORIAN SAM CONGWA.

HE SAID MODERATE AFRICAN LEADERS, SEEKING A HIGHER PROFILE IN THE ORGANISATION OF AFRICAN UNITY WOULD WANT TO REPORT ON THEIR MEETING WITH DE KLERK TO AN OAU SUMMIT LATER THIS YEAR.

RAYMOND LOUW, PUBLISHER OF THE SOUTHERN AFRICA REPORT NEWSLETTER, SAID A SUBSTANTIAL PART OF THE TALKS WOULD BE DEVOTED TO A RECENT UPSURGE IN FIGHTING IN THE 15-YEAR-OLD CIVIL WAR BETWEEN THE ANGOLAN GOVERNMENT AND PRO-WESTERN REBELS,

THE UNITED STATES, MAIN BACKER OF THE REBEL NATIONAL UNION FOR THE TOTAL LIBERATION OF ANGOLA CUNITA), HAS SAID RECENT FIGHTING WAS WRECKING EFFORTS TO END THE WAR THAT HAS RAGED SINCE ANGOLA BECAME INDEPENDENT FROM PORTUGAL IN 1975.

POLITICAL ANALYSTS IN JOHANNESBURG SAID DE KLERK HAD BEEN INVITED LARGELY IN RECOGNITION OF HIS DECISION TO RELEASE MANDELA NINE DAYS AGO AFTER 27 YEARS IN PRISON.

THERE HAS BEEN NO FIRM WORD ON WHICH AFRICAN LEADERS WILL ATTEND BESIDES ZAIRE'S PRESIDENT MOBUTU SESE SEKO.

AFRICAN DIPLOMATS SAID THAT EVEN IF THE MEETING TOOK PLACE IT WOULD NOT BE REPRESENTATIVE OF AFRICA AS A WHOLE.

JOHANNESBURG, FEB 20, REUTER - SOUTH AFRICAN DEFENCE MINISTER MAGNUS MALAN HAS DENIED ORDERING A SECRET ARMY INTELLIGENCE GROUP TO KILL LEADING ANTI-APARTHEID ACTIVISTS.

*GENERAL MALAN SAID NO INSTRUCTIONS WERE EVER GIVEN BY HIM TO ANYBODY TO COMMIT MURDER, + THE DEFENCE MINISTRY SAID IN A STATEMENT ISSUED LATE ON MONDAY.

THE STATEMENT WAS MALAN'S FIRST PUBLIC RESPONSE TO FINDINGS BY A SPECIAL POLICE INVESTIGATION THAT A COVERT ARMY OPERATION, CALLED THE CIVILIAN COOPERATION BUREAU (CCB), MAY HAVE KILLED HUMAN RIGHTS CAMPAIGNER DAVID WEBSTER AND NAMIBIAN LEFTIST LAWYER ANTON LUBOWSKI LAST YEAR.

+NO INSTRUCTIONS WERE GIVEN IN RESPECT OF DR WEBSTER OR MR LUBOWSKI + MALAN'S STATEMENT CONTINUED.

POLICE ARE SEARCHING FOR THREE MEMBERS OF ONE CCB CELL, ALL FORMER POLICEMEN, IN CONNECTION WITH THE TWO SHOOTINGS.

MALAN SAID IN HIS STATEMENT THAT THE CCB HAD PERFORMED ASSIGNMENTS SUCH AS INFILTRATION AND INTELLIGENCE GATHERING, WHICH NO ARMY WOULD WILLINGLY DISCUSS IN PUBLIC.

THE POLICE INVESTIGATIONS INTO THE ARMY ARE IN RESPONSE TO WIDESPREAD ACCUSATIONS OF OFFICIAL USE, OVER YEARS, OF DEATH SQUADS, ARSON ATTACKS AND DIRTY TRICKS TO INTIMIDATE OPPONENTS OF APARTHEID.

PRESIDENT F.W. DE KLERK HAS APPOINTED A JUDICIAL INGUIRY INTO THE ALLEGATIONS, WHICH HAVE EMBARRASSED THE GOVERNMENT JUST AS IT ATTEMPTS TO BEGIN POWER-SHARING NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE RECENTLY LEGALISED ANC.

THE OFFICIAL OPPOSITION IN PARLIAMENT, THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY, SAID ON MONDAY THE GOVERNMENT MUST HAVE KNOWN ABOUT THE ALLEGED ARMY DEATH SQUAD'S ACTIVITIES AND CALLED ON THE CABINET TO RESIGN.

THE ULTRA-RIGHT CONSERVATIVES SAID THE GOVERNMENT HAD DELIBERATELY KEPT QUIET ON THE ISSUE SO THAT THE WORLD WOULD THINK THAT EXTEME RIGHTISTS, AND NOT GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE KILLINGS.

JOHANNESBURG, FEB 20, REUTER - SENIOR ANTI-APARTHEID ACTIVISTS HELD TALKS WITH LAW AND ORDER MINISTER ADRIAAN VLOK ON TUESDAY IN A BID TO END CONFLICT BETWEEN BLACK FACTIONS IN NATAL, WHERE NELSON MANDELA WILL THIS WEEKEND SPELL OUT A MESSAGE OF PEACE.

A DELEGATION FROM THE UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT (UDF) AND THE CONGRESS OF SOUTH AFRICAN TRADE UNLONS (COSATU) MET VLOK IN CAPE TOWN TO DISCUSS HOW TO END THE CONFLICT WHICH HAS COST MORE THAN 2,000 LIVES IN THE PAST THREE YEARS.

+WE PUT A NUMBER OF DETAILED PROPOSALS TO THE MINISTER AND RAISED THE PROBLEMS WE EXPERIENCED. WE FOUND HE WAS QUITE READY TO DEAL WITH THESE PROBLEMS*+ SAID SPOKESMAN ALEC IRWIN AFTER THE MEETING.

HE DECLINED FURTHER COMMENT UNTIL GETTING A DETAILED REPLY ABOUT THE PROPOSALS FROM VLOK.

GROUPS CLOSELY ALLIED TO THE ANC SAID IN A STATEMENT ON TUESDAY THEY WOULD TRY TO STOP CRIMINALS CAPITALISING ON THE WAR IN NATAL BETWEEN THE ZULU-BASED INKATHA MOVEMENT AND THE ANC-ALLIED UDF.
