Works Committee's Report to the Directorate meeting to be held on the 30 th November, 1985.

Special meeting: Late July the committee organised a special meeting in which the importance of division of work was discussed and some of the additional points which were raised included the following:

Manpower: In the last meeting of the Directorate we reported that the Works Committee and the Personal Officer are looking into or considering the possibility of reinforcing the welding Dept. And today we would like to report that two cdes. were requested to work in that section.

Works Committee membership: The Works Committee has started its method of dealing with reps who are not consistent in their dities, more especially attendance of W/C meetings.

On the 8/lo/85 we received a report from cde. Alex, the former rep of the Technical Department, that the rep of the Electrical Dept. was exchanged because he was not doing his work properly.

Structure of Units: We are appealing to the Treasurer to look into the problems of the Supplies Section where the question of structure is not properly understood by the general membership of the Unit. This issue needs immediate
