SUMMARY: I was shocked when comrade Doodles confronted me with a letter on 12/5/83 which stated that there are 8 established kwashiokor cases and 9 children who are at risk, which was not true, these children are given vegetables and fruit every day as far as my records say, I see no point of us having such cases if the children are properly fed.

Anyhow, as comrade Doodles was annoyed with me I went to check with the medical people in the Charlottes and was told that there is no such thing they only disclosed that there are children who are under weight because of malaria.
