The plans must be thought of in terms of effective requests.

UNESCU/UNDP assistance in training ought not be viewed only as applicable to non-socialist countries. Uhy can ee not send persons to Poland for inssin insistence. Study tour can be also be covered. It is time that we utilise these avenues.

May I move toto the budget again .

In 198? permits US to collect a maintenance subsidy of 274.105 US Dollars to cover 677 pupils and students at SUMAFCU at the rate of $$1.00 \times 677 \times 365$. Did we get these funds. The budget tells us that in 1987 and 1988 we have been allocated 30.000 US Dollars each year For eaggndlbbg educational materials and equipment. The non-exgandable component gives us \$40,000\$ in1987 and 55 80,000 in 1988.. He must spend that money For 1988, for I assume that we have Foregone the 1987 allocation. The UNESCU/UNDP projects have bought and will buy us equipment that need maintenance, eg vihecles. Ue have not used this component. If we have , I beg to withdraw the latter statement. There is also the component on sundries us could also use that every year provided that we decide to dos so by September.
