Our Office here in Zambia is neither funded by host government nor by any NGO's. The office only get 'handouts' from the Treasury Committee based here in Zambia which is responsible for sales of ANC properties. Even the 'handouts' depends on whether there were any sales made in a particular period and whether Comrade George Naicker is in a good mood.

We also take this opportunity to request you to acknowledge receipt of our correspondence as we sometimes doubt if you have received it.

We hope that with the information enclosed herein you will be able to solve this matter once and for all.

BREAKDOWN OF ALLOWANCE RECEIVED BY THE CHIEF REPRESENTATIVE
AND HIS STAFF AT THE ANC MISSION IN ZAMBIA.

Allowances from April 1992 to July 1992 were K50.000 each person. The rate of exchange in April 1992 was K46 to R1 (Fourty six Kwachas to One Rand).

For July 1992 the rate of exchange was K60 to R1 (Sixty Kwachas to One Rand).

From August 1992 to January 1993 allowances were K75.000 each person. The rate of exchange in August 1992 was K64 to R1 (Sisty four Kwachas to One Rand).

From December 1992 the rate of exchange was K79 to R1 (Seventy nine Kwachas to One Rand. In January the rate of exchange was K140 to R1 (One Hundred and Fourty Kwachas to One Rand).

From February 1992 the allowances were K140.000 and the rate of exchange was K155 to R1 (One hundred and Fifty five Kwachas to One Rand.

NB.

Kwachas = Zambian Currency

Rand = South African Currency
