Subject: Re ANC/82/002 - Proposed Revision G.

I enclose copy of a letter from Mr. Msimang regarding the above which is self-explanatory.

As we have no copies of an approved Revision F of this project on our files, it will be improper for us to send you a draft for Revision G at this stage. In the meantime, we shall start looking around for locally recruited consultants under paragraph 1 and teachers indicated under paragraph 2.

It would seem, however, that all eight teachers may not be recruited from one country. Mr. Msimang and I will probably have to go on a recruitment drive to a few neighbouring countries which may be willing to assist ANC with the release of one or two teachers.

During the recent Evaluation Mission, Mr. Kotta had agreed to provision being made in project documents for these regional consultant/teacher recruitment missions. We may have to provide for these missions in the next Revision G, if there is nothing for it in F.

As for instructors under para 3, Mr. Msimang has either UNVs in mind or UNDP-funded ANC Cadres on an expanded staff list.

We are anxiously waiting for the approval of Revision F and the accompanying authorization for the purchase of materials and equipment required from Nairobi.
