Agenda: 1 Urgent matters raised by Chaane

The chief explained that yesterday he was called by Chaane and he raised the following questions:

1. Case involving Blossie - that we should follow up the issue as the insurance of our car was still valid.
2. Case of Mr Nyenzwa involving Diana , lawyer claimed 6 million. That we must trace the family and negotiate as they have agreed to settle for K500 000 instead of the 6 000 000 as the lawyers might press for it due to the fact that they will also gain from that amount. It was resolved that this should be followed up with the traffic department so as to trace the family and negotiate. Kgosi to do the job.
3. Another involving a twin cab - Ntshangase wants K870 000 as compensation and it should be followed because it might bring us more problems.
4. The cheque from UNIP was given to Cde Awolo

That comrade Makopo was here and the Musagala case was attended but half-way and that Comrade Musagala must be approached so that he can be convinced that he must not implicate the ANC as this might cost us a lot of money whilst if he accepts responsibility it will be cheaper.

That the office must organise a memorial service for uncle Dan.

That a meeting for office organisation must be held and that even whilst chief was at home he received a lot of complaints about the communication saying that they are rude and short-tempered.
