University Fellowships have been instituted in order to give special recognition to members of the permanent academic staff for distinguished work of special merit in their chosen fields. The standard of the work is judged primarily by publications and the contribution those have made in the particular field.

and publications.

Martin Hermann Prozesky

Martin Prozesky is an ad hominem Professor in Religious Studies. He has published widely in international and local journals, in the fields of philosophy of religion, the concept of human rights, and the experience of religion in South Africa. The author of a book, and editor and contributor to another, on matters of religious theory and practice, Professor Prozesky has also established himself as a major contributor to popular publications, in order to advance a wider understanding of his discipline. The recipient of travelling fellowships, his international academic experience is extensive,

and he is frequently invited to contribute to conferences abroad.

MONGANE WALLY SEROTE

Mongane Wally Serote was born in 1944 in Sophiatown, Johannesburg. He was educated in schools in Alexandra, Leribe (Lesotho) and Soweto. His first poems were published in the late 1960s.

In 1969 he was detained without trial for nine months. His first volume of poems, *Yakhalâ \200\23linkomo*, was published in 1972. In the following year he was awarded the Ingrid Jonker Prize. His second book of poems, *Tsetlo*, appeared in 1974.

In the same year he went as a Fulbright scholar to Columbia University, New York, where he later completed a Masters degree in Film. A long poem, *No Baby Must Weep*, appeared in 1975.

In 1977 he returned from the USA to Botswana, where he lived for nine years. There he became involved in the organisation of the Medu Arts Ensemble. Further books from his pen appeared: *Behold Mama*

*Flowers* (poems) in 1978, *To Every Birth its Blood* (a novel) in 1981, and *Selected Poems and The Night Keeps Winking* (poems) in 1982. In 1983 he received a Creative Writing Award from the English Academy of Southern Africa. The Academy judged him to be one of the three most significant writers to have emerged in South Africa in the 1970s. Most critics and commentators agree that he is the most distinguished of his generation of poets; many see him as one of South Africa's most important writers.

Wally Serote had always been a cultural and political activist, and in 1986 he moved to London, where he became the cultural attaché of the ANC in the United Kingdom and the first head of the ANC Department of Arts and Culture. In 1987 another long poem, *A Tough Tale*, was published, and in 1990 *On the Horizon*, a collection of essays.

He has recently moved back to South Africa. The University of Natal honours Mongane Wally Serote for the quality of his literary achievement, for

the humane vision and dedication shown in both his work and his life, and for the contribution that he has made and continues to make to the establishment of a really new South Africa.

CHRISTIAAN FREDERICK BEYERS  
NAUDE

Beyers Naudé was born in 1915 in Roodepoort. He studied at the University of Stellenbosch where he became President of the Students' Representative Council and obtained the degrees of BA and MA and became a licentiate in theology.

From 1941 to 1963 he was a minister of the Dutch Reformed Church in various places. Towards the end of this period he became increasingly concerned about the human and theological implications of Government policies and of certain DRC viewpoints and attitudes. He was the first editor of the questioning journal Pro Veritate. In 1963 he was elected Moderator of the Southern Transvaal Synod of the DRC, but in the same year he founded and became Director of the Christian Institute.

After this his religious, intellectual and political views broadened progressively, but he was rejected by his church and denounced by the Government. In 1977 the Christian Institute was declared an illegal organisation, and Beyers Naudé and several other leading members of the Institute were banned. He had however been awarded honorary degrees by the Free University of Amsterdam and the University of Witwatersrand, and was the recipient of the Reinhold Niebuhr Prize from the University of Chicago and the Human Rights Award of the Free Church of Sweden.

While he was banned he was visited and consulted not only by many South Africans but by overseas theologians, academics and politicians.

In 1984 he was unbanned, and in the following year became the General Secretary of the South African Council of Churches. He has played an important role in recent socio-political and religious developments. He has also received further honorary doctorates and awards - for example those given by the Austrian Bruno Kreisky Foundation and the U.S. F.D. Roosevelt Freedom Foundation and also the Robert F. Kennedy Human Rights Award.

The University of Natal honours Beyers Naudé for his constant and courageous pursuit of human, spiritual and social truth in South Africa.
