TWO men and a woman, ap- . pearing before Mr T Reed in the Durban Regional Court, have pleaded not guilty to a charge of contravening the In- . ternal Security Act.

. Before the Court were Mr Welcome Vukane Mhlongo, 28, of Chesterville; Mr Nkosinathi Lancelot Mazibuko, 22, of Kwa Mashu; and Miss Ntombenhle Charity Mazibuko, 26, of Lamontville.

The first two accused have $a\200\230$ refused $a\200\231$ to participate in the trial, saying that as $a\200\230$ soldiers $a\200\231$ they should not be in a civilian court.

They are not represented and have declined to cross-examine any State witnesses.

It is alleged Miss Mazibuko was recruited by Mr Mhlongo to act as a courier for the ANC.

The two men are alleged to have left South Africa and undergone military training with the ANC in Angola and later in Yugoslavia.

The first man is alleged to have left the country in December 1985 and the other in January 1986.
