POSTGRADUATE ACCOMMODATION

Details of Accommodation Available for First Year Postgraduates

The University offers a limited amount of accommodation for single postgraduate students. This consists of:-

(a) David Collett Hall

This is a fully catering hall and offers a package deal of a serviced room plus 21 meals a week. Rooms are let for a 39 week period (three terms plus the Christmas and Easter vacations). Self-catering accommodation is available for the Summer Vacation.

(b) Flats in Falkner/Eggington Courts

These flats house eight students per flat with his or her own study bedroom but communal cooking, dining and washing facilities. The flats are centrally heated and the kitchens are fully equipped. Each flat is serviced to the extent of eight hours per week. Students must provide their own cutlery and crockery. Everything else is provided by the University. Rooms are let for 50 weeks, 39 weeks or 3 x 10 weeks.

(c) Nine Houses in Borrowdale Way

These modern houses have been adapted to take four postgraduate students, each with his or her own study bedroom but communal cooking, dining and washing facilities. The University provides all the necessary equipment (including bed linen and crockery), the heating and lighting and limited cleaning service. These are let on a 50 week basis.

Please note that accommodation is available from the Saturday prior to the commencement of the Autumn Term and will be kept only until the following Monday unless you confirm, with the Accommodation Secretary, that you intend to arrive late.

Married Students

The University has no accommodation for married students but the University Lodgings Officer, Mrs J Meyer, will help in finding suitable accommodation in the area. Suitable accommodation is limited and the University cannot guarantee to find accommodation.

Administrative Procedure

Please fill in the application form and return to the Accommodation Secretary. A booking fee of £30.00 must be sent with the application form. The Accommodation Secretary will then send either a confirmation of booking or a letter stating that no booking can be made. If accommodation is not available the booking fee will be returned. If accommodation is offered and accepted the booking fee should be used to offset residential charges. In the event of the accommodation being offered but not accepted or rejected, or having been accepted and not cancelled prior to the date quoted on the accommodation acceptance form the booking fee will not be returned.

Accommodation for postgraduates is limited and you are advised not to delay your application.
