

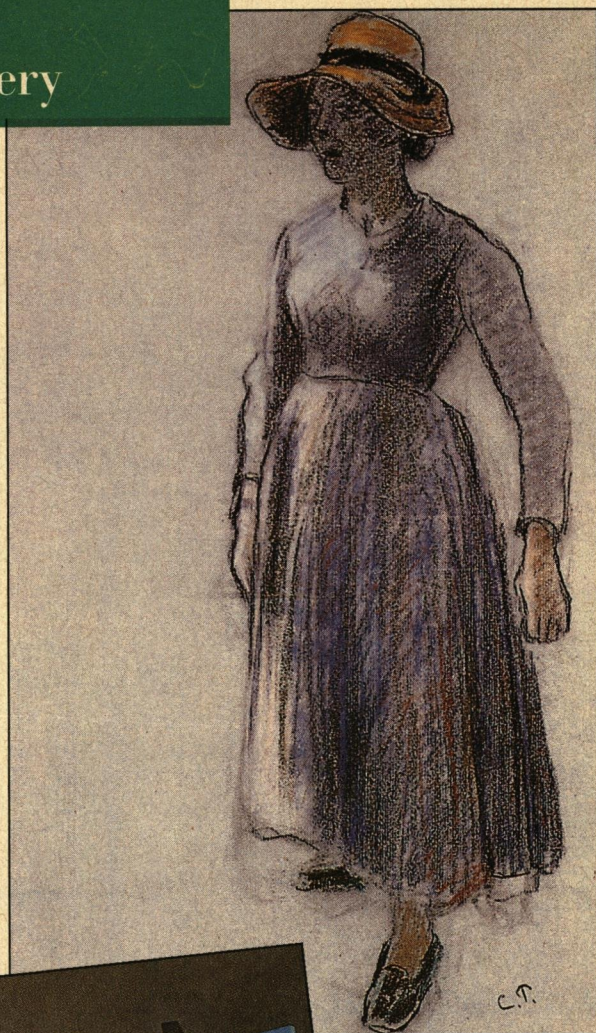

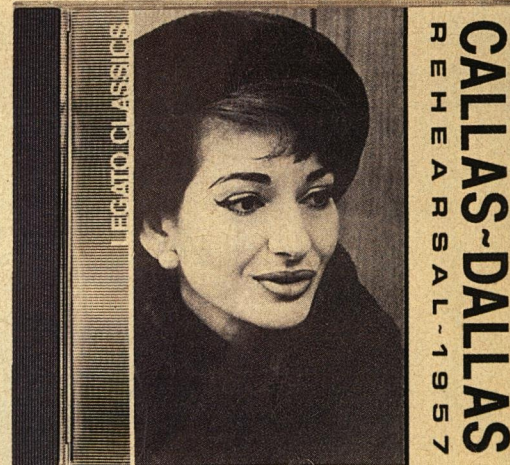
LIGHT IN THE DARK

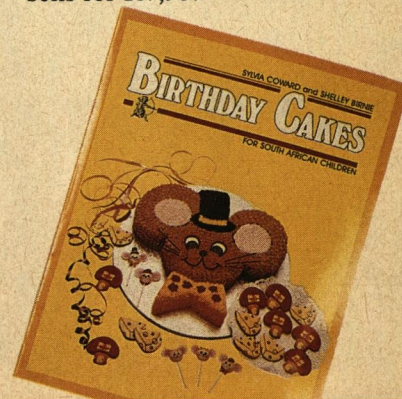
COLLECTIBLE

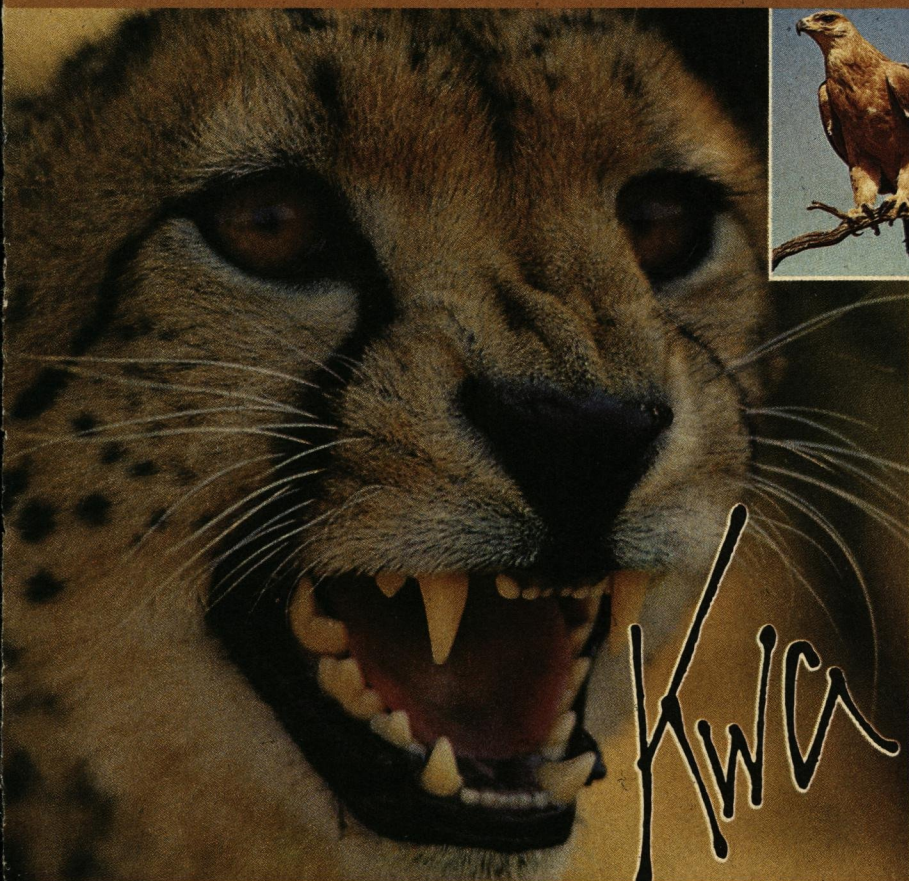
