- 5; It is worth mentioning that the study conducted by the OAU General Secretariat has helped to analyze objectively disasters in Africa, their extent, measures undertaken to combat disasters and the preparation of guidelines to prevent disasters in the Continent. . .
- 6; It is not pbssibble to prescribe a uniform pattern of national preparedness of contingency planning for all coudtries since their resources, administrative structure and infrastructurel facilities vary widely; Furthermore, it is not appropriate to recommend a rigid set of guidelines for all disasters even for the same country, since each disaster has its own pecularities; A copy of the document is attached for easy reference;
