RE: GCE JANUARY 1994 CANDIDATES' SCHEDULE


Please, find attached a schedule to show dates when SAEU learners from your centre are expected to arrive in Dar es Salaam to do their GCE examinations. Please, note that as a measure for managing the high cost of administering the examinations, the SAEU cannot pay candidates night allowances if they arrive in Dar more than two days before the date of their first papers. Furthermore, candidates will be expected to return to Mgagao Centre when the interval between their successive papers exceeds five days.

Kindly make the necessary arrangements for the candidates to be allowed to travel to Dar es Salaam and seek the guidance of your Dar office in identifying suitable accommodation for the candidates; because the SAEU is not responsible for these commitments. You will be responsible also to pay the students fares to Dar es Salaam from the special imprest issued to you.

Candidates must be reminded to bring their GCE Statement of Entry Forms (DPG C9) and attend all their papers as shown in their forms. Their night allowances will be paid a day after their arrival in Dar es Salaam. The SAEU accountant will issue payments from 1100 - 1300 hours from Monday to Sunday.
