Noting that I have been on leave during July 1993, I have been in contact with the two projects to ascertain their present state in order to write this report.

DAKAWA ARTS AND QRAFT PRQJEQT:

The main aspects of this project are:

- 1) Cde Malin Sellman the Director of the project is currently on leave and will be writing a fuller report on her return on the 14th of August 1993.
- 2) One of the most urgent tasks that they are undertaking at present is to find a South African citizen to take the position as deputy director of the project in order that he/she can take over when Malin finishes her contract at the end of June 1993 . SIDA have stated that they need her replacement to be put in place as soon as possible .
- 3) During my leave I visited Rorkes Drift and spoke to Princess Ngcobo who is a trustee of the Project. She feels that it is important for the trust to look at the profitability of the project once the donors have withdrawn from the project.
- 4) Cde Vusi Khumaio will be leaving for Sweden in September 1993 to continue his studies at a college in Stockholm.
- 5) Naomi Duiker who is the administrator at the project has told me that the project is running satisfactorily in Malin's absence.
- 6) Cde Lebona Mosea the chairperson of the trust has contacted Ismael Ayob about the transfer of the property from Dakawa Properties to Dakawa Arts and Crafts Project Trust.

 BLQEMFQNTEIN PRQJEQT:

At a meeting that was convened by Cde Bongani from the Finance Department between the DAC which was represented by Cdes Uriel Abrahamse and Dikki Dewar and the NPA funders it was decided that it was very unlikely that this project would be able to be launched this year and that the monies for both 1992 and 1993 could be better

utilised in another area possibly in the cultural work in the coming elections campaign.

HIL REN' FE TIVAL:

In mid April a week before the CDC conference the 100 children from the PWV structures went to the Kruger National Park and had a chance to observe the Nature Reserve , experience different forms of Art and to learn more about the Childrens rights charter. This was filmed and screened on the Artworks programme. This project was a major success thanks to the concientious effort of Cde Liz Castle. This years festival was funded by the Canadian Embassy, who have after this success agreed to fund the project again in 1992. During the CDC Conference the children from the festival performed at the Johannesburg Art Gallery to the delegates from the conference. Artworks that were created were exhibited at this event.

Plans for the 1993 Children's festival will be started in earnest in September 1993. Cde Liz Castle can be contacted at tel. no. 463.4173 in this respect.

I have asked Cde Gabriel Sethloke to assist me in the drawing up of this report as he has been appointed as the person to deal with DAC in respect of Dorkay House and the NPA funded projects that are based there. This project has just received half of their 1993 NPA funding amount.

Dorkay House have a number of projects in the pipeline: The final preparations for the South Africa-Detroit cultural exchange (which has been postponed twice) is now being made for September 1993. This will consist of a month long jazz workshop through Dorkay House . The financial facilitation will be arranged through Tusk Records, Nedbank and Gilbeys. Gilbeys are organising a Dorkay House benefit show at the Moretele Park . The Proceeds will go towards this cultural exchange programme.

Dorkay House are further launching of the groups from exile and Robben Island, the show will be known as "Freedom Melody".Cde Jonas Gwangwa is to assess the Amandla script in order to ensure that the show is professional at this launch. A meeting of all the participants is being convened for the 11th of August. at this meeting a final date for this launch will be established. The project of renovating Dorkay House is in full swing , starting with the auditorium which has been painted and the floors are being tiled. Three of the offices have been painted and fully carpeted . A propre sound system will be installed in the auditorium. The renovations will be continuing during August.
