Whereas the complainant, Mr. Yobe Mtonga of Chawama, Lusaka, did sustain a bullet wound on the left leg after having been fired upon by comrade July Rapelang - a member of the African National Congress, be it hereby known that the comrade was not in the course of performing his duties as assigned by the ANC.

Be it hereby further known that the ANC regrets that such an unfortunate inceident had to happen, and condemns in the strongest of terms any irresponsible behaviour from its cadres. The offecnder has to bear the consequences of his act.

Considering the fraternal bonds that exist between our organsisation and the people of Zambia, and in an attempt to strengthen these bonds, it would be proper for the ANC to display a token of sympathy with the complainant, purely on humanitarian grounds, by compensating him with whatever amount the office can afford. This, however, should not be interpreted as accepting responsibility for the actions of the accused.
