MAZIMBU FILM PROJECT

AIMES

- I. To portray Mazimbu of a future, free and democratic SA, and to prove that the cadres of the ANC have the capabilities, knowhow and skill in running and governing a SA free of apartheid, racism and exploitation.
- 2. To prove to the doners of Mazimbu that the money, machinery and other other materials they have donated are being used productively.
- 3. To disprove the allegations of the SA regime that young South Africans are being forced to train in the camps of Umkonto; that these youths are given the opportunity to developethemselves politically and educationally and that they are being well cared for by the ANC.
- 4. To prove the SOMAFCO provides a real and positive alternative to the present Bantu Education system in SA, and to expose Bantu Education as the most reactionary educational programme established on the African continent by making a comparison with ANC education, presently being implimented at SOMAFCO in accordance with the Freedom Charter.
