The Chairman, Regional Preparatory Committee Circular No. 4 October 1984.

Re: Preparations for NCC.

The National Preparatory Committee wishes to convey to you the following decisions:

1. That for the purpose of strengthening and maximising preparations, it is the considered view of the NPC that in each region the Chief Representative and Chairman of the Regional Political Committee should sit in the Conference Preparatory Committees as ex-officio members.

It is important that these two senior officials of the movement in each region should, through the structures which they head, create the necessary atmosphere for Preparatory Committees to achieve maximum participation of the general membership in each region. For this reason and the fact that the normal organizational work will have to continue in each region, it will be better if these two officials are not further asigned official positions in the Preparatory Committees e.g as Chairman/Deputy etc. The NPC envisages a situation where in the near future, Preparatory Committees will have to function on a full time basis.

2. That the Regional Youth and Women Section, as mass political organs of the movement should each second a representative to the Regional Preparatory Committee.

3. Reports to NPC

Regions are advised not to wait until the whole discussion document is exhausted before reporting to the NPC. Regional Preparatory Committees are requested to convey to the National Preparatory Committee the discussions and recommendations made at unit and branch level so that the NPC can circulate some of these recommendations to the general membership to enrich discussions and to oncourage those branches, units, regions who might be lagging behind.
