We have received the copy of the letter sent to Alitalia office in Dar es Salaam. From it we gathered that there were tickets which were sent to the Lusaka Alitalia office from the Embassy of Bulgaria. On investigation we discovered that the PTA named in the letter was already issued and that the four no-names on the PTA were not specifically mentioned for the ANC. As a result we were in no position to claim the said tickets.

Please advise on the Shangase issue since there seems to be no notice of his withdrawal from the Bulgarian list. Are we supposed to inform him to prepare to go to Bulgaria since Vusi has instructed him to proceed to school and not bother about the family problems he reports to have. Similarly the case of Nomalizo Kraai, we sent you a letter informing you about the decision to withdraw her from the list but we are surprised to still find her name in the list you sent to us. Find out also when we can receive the final word from Bulgaria about the placements of these students.

We had earlier on asked you to furnish us the details of the ILO offer, but to date we have received no reply to that effect. We are hearing rumours about the offer but we have no definite information on this offer. Please make this offer clear to us. As we have sent to you the list of the students that have been applied for in Cuba, we are still awaiting the reply from them to inform us about the travel arrangements. There are the Rankoe who also appear on the same list, our suggestion is that we request UNESCO to transport them to Dar. Even those from London could something be done to assist their travelling to Dar to join the rest of the students leaving for Cuba.
