Concerning the sending of the things, it would be appreciated if you could work with the Solidarity Committee of the Soviet Union, so that the equipment could be sent as a gift of solidarity to the African National Congress in Luanda (Angola).

In your letter dated the 10th March, you mention that you are in the process of drawing necessary posters and various paintings, could you please inform us how far you have gone and if they are ready, could you kindly send them to the National Preparatory Committee for the Festival at the Headquarters.

We would appreciate it if you could attend to this matter of the amplifiers and speakers as soon as possible, because our comrades in Angola are desperately in need of them.
