RE: ASSISTANCE FOR OUPA MOFOKENG

We have been informed that the Lutheran World Federation is willing to assist Oupa Mofokeng, an exile/refugee from South Africa currently enrolled for theology at our college.

As required by you we would like to state the following:

1. It is hereby confirmed that Oupa Mofokeng is a student at Justo Mwale Theological College (JMTC).
2. We would like to support his application for assistance regarding his tuition and boarding fees, as well as other items he may need for his sustenance whilst studying at JMTC.

The amount required for tuition and boarding fees is K82 000.00 (eighty two thousand kwacha only) per annum. This includes a very basic monthly student allowance. Basic stationary and prescribed books are provided as part of the tuition fees, but if the student wants to buy extra stationary or books it must be bought cash. Students also receive one bulb per term free of charge.

In addition he will basically need the following:

1. 1 bed
2. 1 mattress
3. 1 table for eating
4. 1 chair
5. A small stove (two plate)
6. Cooking and eating utensils
7. Beddings
8. Bookshelf


JMTC provided Mr Mofokeng with some of these items from our own stock. These items are actually meant for students from participant churches. We are not unwilling to assist Mr Mofokeng as far as possible. The point is that we have little in reserve when emergency replacements need to be done. We will therefore be happy if you could assist him and us as far as possible in acquiring some of these items.
