1. You will recall that at our National Education Committee meeting on 1 April, and subsequently in our consultations with the members of the education alliance, we had proposed a strategy that would involve engaging both state and capital in an effort to resolve the education crisis.

The National Education Conference resolutions, included inter alia:

- the setting up a post conference structure to implement the resolutions of Conference
- the need to develop a strategy to engage state and capital

The National Education Conference Working Group was established in April and has met on two occasions and has developed the attached proposal. (draft)

We would appreciate your comments on this draft proposal.

2. As part of the discussions of the Working Group's planning committee, it was agreed that the National Education

Conference would encourage the establishment and development of Regional Educational structures that would in composition reflect the constituencies of the Education Conference. The various members of the National Education Conference have undertaken responsibility to facilitate the creation of regional structures. The purpose of these structures would be to enhance the broad educational alliance at regional level; develop more effective report back, consultative and accountability mechanisms, ensure effective back up from mass based constituencies in our initiative to engage state and capital. The ANC's Education department committed itself to playing a leading role in setting up the regional education committees in the following areas: PWV, Border, N OFS, N Cape, Natal Midlands.

Other constituent members of the National Education Conference will facilitate the establishment of regional committees in the other regions. It is important that our regional education committees are actively involved in this process.

3. We are currently planning a time table that will enable us to follow up on the Policy Conference. A great deal of work has still to be done. It would be extremely useful if your committee could let us have names and contact addresses of persons who could facilitate policy workshops in the regions.
