MEMORANDUM SUBMITTED TO THE AFRO-ASIAN SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE OF THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLYC BY THE AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS OF SOUTH AFRICA, MAY, 1978

Since the 1976 student uprising in Soweto and elsewhere in South Africa, a large number of young people have been forced to flee the country to avoid intimidation, arrests, torture and in many instances killings in custody.

Thousands of these young destitute people sought out the external missions of our organisation for assistance. The African National Congress in turn made urgent and pressing appeals for help to very close friends and supporters. The people and government of the German Democratic Republic, regarded as one of our close friends and allies, came to our immediate rescue through the Afro-Asian Solidarity Committee.

Urgent steps were taken to ship and airlift food, clothing, medicines, bedding and blankets etc. in large quantities to avert a fest deteriorating situation in our various camps.

The struggling, oppressed and exploited masses of South Africa, especially our young cadres, will always remember the noble role and tremendous sacrifice made by the G.D.R. as part of their solidarity with the down-trodden. This also conforms with their international role of support to the liberation movements.

In submitting the enclosed requisition we once more wish to express our gratitude and sincere thanks to the peoples of the German Democratic Republic for their unstinted support.
