Dakawa and Mazimbu, the activities to be given priority
and the relevant reallocation,
(c) discuss and agree on the reallocation of the unallocated
NOK 8,590,000 of the 1991 budget. (para 5.3 of the Agreed
Minutes),
(d) discuss the possible scenarios for 1992
1. OBJECTIVE OF THE NORWEGIAN ASSISTANCE TO ANC
"While the basic objectives for the Norwegian assistance
remain, the Norwegian assistance for the remaining part
of 1991 shall, however, primarily be decided in the
light of ANC's decision to phase out the activities in
Dakawa and Mazimbu".
2. ACTIVITY PROGRAMME AND BUDGET REVIEW
2.1 Review of the 1991 budget situation for Tanzania per end

2.2 Dakawa - Mazimbu
In view of the ANC phasing out policy it will be kg
9 necessary to start negotiations immediately with the 3
% Tanzanian Authorities for the future use of Dakawa
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V The requirements of the Tanzanian Authorities shall 1
E thus become part of the input to the planning
1 process for the work to be carried out in the
phasing out period.
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All contracts, existing and new, shall be (re)considered in view of the amended plans. An Action/Activity Plan is being prepared by the Task Force and shall be further elaborated considering the consequences of the change in policy and corresponding activities shall be prepared. Dakawa Construction Works

Principally there shall be no investments in new construction work. All existing construction t'COntracts shall, however, be satisfactorily completed in accordance with Appendices 1 and 2. With reference to outstanding issues, the following items were discussed and agreed:

- (a) Permanent Water Supply
- The total budget is NOK 8,3 million. Total available funds per 30.06.91 is

approximately NOK 6.7 million.

The total amount of allocated NOK 5 million for permanent Water Supply shall be released on the following conditions:

- (i) The design criteria shall be reviewed in light of the revised ANC phasing out policy and the future taking over by the le) Tanzania Authorities;
- (ii) The Tanzanian Authorities, including MAJI H05 and Regional Water Engineer, Morogoro, shall be involved in the planning and approval of the selection of source and technology with the view to MAJI's future Operation & Maintenance (O&M) responsibilities;
- (iii) ANC and NPA representatives with assistance of the Norwegian Embassy, DSM, will approach the Tanzanian Authorities without delay to clarify the above points; (iv) The additional funds required to complete the scheme shall be considered in the 1992 budget allocations.
- (b) Sewage System

The present system is designed for a much larger population than now envisaged for Dakawa. A study of the system to consider the needs for today's situation and future possible scenarios shall therefore be carried out without delay.

Operation and Maintenance

An Operation and Maintenance Organisation Structure shall be further elaborated, including specification of relevant equipment, Job Descriptions, manuals and routines, and training of relevant ANC and Tanzanian personnel. A corresponding budget shall be prepared OW%%/

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and submitted to MFA.

Training - VTC

A sum of NOK 500,000 shall be reallocated to support recurrent expenditures, including purchase of some tools and machinery, for the remaining Bart of 1991. This should be regarded as a stop-gap measure until required funds are secured from other donors for 1992.

Scholarships - Dakawa.

The remaining NOK 700.000 may be disposed for scholarships according to existing plans. Amounts required to complete ongoing scholarships shall be assumed to be made available for the phasing-out period.

Management and Administration

- (a) Organisational structures
- (1) ANC

ANC shall provide an Organisational Structure for the Task Force, the Management Committee and the Project Management Board, including relevant Terms of References, Job Descriptions and personnel plans. ANC shall contract key personnel for the periods in question. A corresponding budget shall be prepared. (ii) NPA

NPA shall in view of the change of activities agreed in this document present a plan for their personnel disposition in DSM and Oslo, with a corresponding budget.

Both plans to be presented by 15 July 1991.

(b! Salarx scheme

The request for assistance in the amount of USD 250.000 will be granted on the following conditions:

- (i) that a salary budget is prepared;
- (ii) that other donors' contributions to satisfy a
 minimum budget are committed;
- (iii)that a payment system satisfactory to the
 donors and employees is prepared;

Repatriation Plan

A repatriation plan shall be prepared to ensure an orderly and manageable repatriation and to ensure that Dakawa and Mazimbu are properly administered throughout the phasing-out period. Equipment and installations shall remain in the settlements to ensure that they are handed over in proper working

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order. To this end an inventory shall be carried out without delay.

The Repatriation Plan shall be presented by the end of July 1991.

Procurement

The frozen amount of NOK 2.4 million will be used for completing the construction works and to cover material and consulting services for operation and maintenance purposes.

Daily Necessities - Frontline States
On the basis of information provided by ANC regarding the number of refugees still in exile in the various Frontline States, it was agreed that there will be no changes for 1991.

Farm in Zambia

In the Annual Meeting, 1990, MFA requested economic and production information on the farm. Information was submitted in April 1991 in the form of a report "Summary Report of Activities for the Period 1990-91".

Scholarships outside Tanzania

The 1991 Scholarship budget allows NOK 800,000 for students in Zambia and Zimbambwe.

An additional amount of NOK 750.000 shall be reallocated for utilisation in 1991 to cover part of the cost of additional students for short term courses and vocational training in Zimbabwe. This shall not mean that funds will be made available for 1992.

Department of Information and Publicity
The request for funds for 1991 (NOK 913,000) shall
be reconsidered. Specific alternat. a budgets for
the disposition of the funds for 1991 shall be
presented by ANC by the end of June. Payment shall
be made by MFA in two installments to ANCs external
account in London. Accounting report shall be
submitted by ANC to MFA for the utilisation of the
funds. An additional amount of NOK 360.000 shall be
reallocated for utilisation in 1991. NOK 300.000 is
reallocated from the overall budget contingencies.
Department of Arts and Culture

ANC shall present a plan on how to utilise the funds for 1991 (NOK 800.000) in Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe as soon as possible.

ANC OFFICE IN DAR ES SALAAM

It was agreed that the sum of NOK 899,000. originally intended for the construction of new ANC office premises, shall be made available for the

renting, furnishing and maintenance of ANC oi ices in DSM up till the end of 1992.

4. ACTIVITIES IN SOUTH AFRICA

MFA agreed to support the ANC National Conference in Durban in July 1991 in the amount of NOK 1,250,000. MFA agreed to support the ANC Womens' League in 1991 with an amount of NOK 750.000.
