### COMMENT ON STATISTICS

Odi Prison

The remaining 4 hunger strikers in Odi prison have been transferred to Odi hospital. This brings the total of hunger strikers in hospital to 23.

#### HEALTH CONDITIONS

#### Odi Hospital

The 18 prisoners in Odi hospital enter their 24th day of hunger strike today. They are all suffering severe weight loss of up to 22 kgs and complain of dizziness, stomach cramps and loss of concentration. We received a report on the health conditions of the following 9 hunger strikers:

- Johannes Simelane: Johannes is confined to bed and can only move around in a wheel chair. His legs are numb and he has complained of feeling dizzy and having difficulty concentrating and hearing. Johannes lost 22 kgs and now weighs 48 kgs.
- Johannes Bushy Molefe: He is suffering from severe kidney and back pain. He is also having problems with his eyesight and and has developed diarroeha. Johannes complains of chest pain, insomnia and of having difficulty talking.
- David Mosebi: He has backache and kidney pain and cannot see properly. David (24) has lost 18 kgs.
- Thapelo Manyeneng: He complains of stomach problems including diamohea and stomach cramps. He also suffers from nervous problems and backache. Thapelo is also 24 years old.
- He has an extremely low blood pressure (80/50), and had to to be transferred to Ga Rankuwa hospital because Odi hospital does not have the facilities to treat his problem.
- Augustine Twaibile: Augustine has lost 10 kgs and is experiencing heart palpitations and an irregular pulse. He also complains of constant head and backache.
- Zachamia Seabi: He has lost 13 kgs and is having difficulties sleeping and concentrating.
- Patrick Mongake: Patrick has problems with concentration and dizziness.

  His blood pressure is fluctuating and he has lost 17 kgs.
- He is experiencing difficulty with sleeping and occasional numbness in his legs. Frans, who was previously on hunger strike for 23 days in May, complains also of sore eyes and failing concentration.
