1. MR N N NOGWEBU

A letter was received from Mr N N Nogwebu, dd 31/01/1992, in which he informs the University that he no longer intends to attend meetings as he had been given early retirement as Director-General by the Ciskei Government. He also indicates that the agendas of future meetings should be directed to the office of the Director-General, Department of Education. 1

Mr Nogwebu was appointed by the Head of State, according to Amendment Decree No. 9 of 1990, in terms of the following section:-

"(1)(b) not less than seven members appointed to hold office at his pleasure by the Head of State in consultation with such persons as are in his opinion representative of the University Community "

In my opinion, and in consultation with Prof du Plessis, this is interpreted that Mr Nogwebu, in his personal capacity, and not his professional capacity, was appointed to the University Council. He therefore remains a member of the Council until he officially resigns, and should thus receive agendas as in the past.

2. REV M A STOFIE

Rev Stofie was appointed in terms of the following section of the Fort Hare Amendment Decree No. 9 of 1990:-

"(1) (d) four members elected by Convocation from among its number: MM
no person who's game brought the Mshall be eligible for Mn
under this whf

As Rev Stofile was appointed Director of Public Relations, he can no longer be a member of Council. Convocation will have to elect another member. Council will also have to elect a Council Representative on the University Staffing Committee.

Please let me have your comments on this situation as soon as possible.
