Greetings:

There are several issues that I wish to take up with you as Follows:

1. Ode Jimmy Phambo has indicated to me that the move for Mampinga from unit One to Unit Three should be affected forthwith. She is now employed in Unit Three.
2. The house that she is still occupying in unit One has to be cleaned and repainted according to Matron L'Aloria before she can be expected to move in.
3. The Tanzanian teacher Zurah Othman is still living on the complex and is occupying a room in the house where Cde Tunga lives. Please note that this teacher no longer works at the primary school. We do not understand how she can remain on the complex without working for the AND. She was informed in December 1989 of this decision.
4. The room in my house in Copenhagen that will be vacated when the Nigerian volunteer leaves is scheduled to be occupied by the new teacher from Sweden when she arrives in April 1990.
5. We need two rooms in Units One & Two for new teachers who will be starting to work at the primary school in April before school opens on 9th. There is the possibility of employing a third ANS teacher who should come for an interview soon.
6. We need one room in Unit One where a new matron who has already been employed will live. This must also be done now because she cannot work until we have a place for her to live.

We hope that these can be implemented by April 5 1990.
