The LMT 'f gOffices in Lagos and Keno will close on December 31st,1994. In this circulm M, I wish to hig-lign.t the implications of " the closure of our office vis-a-vis your remainin mg in Ixigeria. Thn'polltlcal and. educat ional crises in Nigeria are beyond our .eco\_ntrol. . The situation is such that nobody is able to predi ct 'when any educational programme or course of s tudy will be fe6mpleted. This state of affairs is particularly irksome to our T,dQHOrs. They can no longer c ontinue pumping money into a I cholarshlp programme that caters lor students whose ac ademio 6N:r6gramm956 duratlon continues to be extended year alter year due fto ciesure 6f academic institutions. The Australian Government Chas as such,categorical3y informed us that there will be no -provison of funds for our programme a\_fter December 31st 1994.
