A bilateral meeting was held between the African National Congress and the South African Government from the 20th - 22nd and the 25th - 26th of January 1993. The Government delegation was led by Mr Roelf Meyer, Minister of Constitutional Development, and the African National Congress delegation was led by Mr Cyril Ramaphosa, Secretary General of the ANC. Security matters were' discussed during the first two days.

Various models exploring issues such as a government of national unity and regional government were considered. Various matters that were canvassed at CODESA such as procedures to appoint a new SABC Board, and Independent Media Commission, Indeendent Electoral Commission and the reincorporation of the TBVC states were also explored. The two delegations will be reporting to principals with a view to resolving matters and finalising the resumption of multi-party negotiations. Further discussions between the two parties will be taking place.
