
I want to bring to your attention and implementation or action the following:-

1. ANC Health Board - by recommendation of the last Health Council - long overdue.
2. The need for a pharmacist - the present pharmacist, really an industrial pharmacist, is due for school some time this year. If we are to get our Drugs records straight, this matter must be given priority attention.
3. The committee for doctors to process medical histories of patients meriting treatment abroad. As there are already a number of complaints this committee could work in close association with the Health Board.

A copy of the functions and composition of this Health Board is herewith enclosed, as defined at the Health Council.

STRUCTUREANC HEALTH BOARD:

The above body be independent and sit when required to do so by the Secretariat or E.C.C.

Its functions are: -

1. To look after the interests of patients following any complaints from them concerning alleged abuse, or neglect of duty, resulting in harm to them.
2. To investigate charges of malpractice for example drunkenness on duty, neglect of duty by medical staff.
3. To investigate instances of breaches of patient CONFIDENTIALITY.
4. To look after the interests of health staff e.g. to investigate instances of slander, abuse or character assassination of members of health staff.

COMPOSITION:

1. A legal person
2. A doctor of high rate
3. A nurse of high rate
4. A member of the N.E.C.
5. A responsible and highly respected member of the A.N.C. community.

(Numbers: 2 and 3 should not be office - bearers of the Health Department).
