a. I just returned from an official visit to Beijing, where we asked them,among others, to support ANC Aopeak at UNSC when we ask for more UN election monitors in the forth coming UN Session in September.

b. It is possible that the ZS parties at Multiracial Negotiating Forum may announce in June 3 the date for the first multiracial election and inauguration of Transitional Executive Council T.E.C. If that happens then immediately all Economic and Financial Sanctions will be lifted.Voter Education and Election Campaign will then be launched.
