Dear Comrade,

The comrades in Luanda have got a small sewing shop going and are going to increase their output shortly.

In the meantime they need khaki cloth.

You have several rolls of these in the Mazimbu stores. Could you please make arrangements to have these sent to Lusaka with an "A" written on the bundles in a conspicuous place. Also send a covering note to the Treasury saying it is for onward transmission to Luanda. If there are any in Mbeya, the same thing should happen.

In the meantime I am here in Luanda making enquiries about the possibility of getting a ship to shift goods from here to Maputo and especially for Dar.

I hope to either arrange for these goods to be taken round the South by ship - or back to Europe and transferred to another ship going down the East Coast from there.

As soon as any results accrue from these negotiations, I will let you know.
