- 1. We received the tantative flight schedule for comrade Deputy President. Thanks.
- 2. Hong-Kong: According to the schedule Cde Deputy President, on route to Japan, will stop-over in Hong Kong from 08:00-13:40 April 20,1991. What will the Deputy President see or do during his 5 hours plus transit in Hong Kong? Please advice.
- 3. Recommendations for Hong Kong
- Either(i) We arrange a place to rest at the Airport Transit Hotel for the entire 5 hours.
- or (ii) We arrange a 4 hours rest at the Transit Hotel and one hour drive arround Hong Kong for sightseeing.
- or (iii) We arrange 3 hours rest at the Transit Hotel and
- (a) 10 minutes courtesy call to the Governor Sir Wilson and
- (b) 50 minutes Press Conference at the Airport Transit Hotel.

Issues to address will be

- (a) Persuade Hong Kong business men to exercise patience about investing in South Africa. Hong Kong, Taiwan and South Korea frustrated almost all U.N. efforts (except minor token measures) to impose sanction in S.A.. Hong Kong and Taiwanese companies are largest investors in Bantustands.
- (b) Counter negative rapotage that Apartheid is dead and that the only obstacle to negotiation is "Black on Black violence between Buthelezi's Zulu supporters-Conservative and Madiba's mainly Xhosa supporters-socialist."
- (c) Address the move by S.A.government and Chinese business people to woe frightened cisizens about "China 1997-Hong Kong to be ruled by mainland China"to migrate to South Africa and help set-up "China-Towns."
- (d) Our own perspectives and numerous initiatives we took to mobilise the c ountry for peace. -Needs of our people.
- (e) De Klerk is billed to visit the region in few months to come and he is seen as engine-of-change in South Africa.
- (f) Also to strengthen the 3 years old Anti-Apartheid movement in this British Colony.
