We are seeking work in East Africu which would provide us both the opportunity to do a combination of direct patient caref and clinical teaching. We would ideally like to work in a socielist country with a health service, or in the process of setting one up. We understand that Tanzania may he in need of health care personnel with skills such as ours.

My training is broad in that I did my undergraduate medical training at a very traditional, academically oriented institution and the bulk of my postgraduate training at e, small community hospital. Ry clinical experience, both in training and since, includes a good deal of obstetrical and neonatal work. I am trained to do Cesarian sections and an comfortable backing up midwives. Due to the Asian, Mexican and Central American immigrant populations I served during my residency training I have some practical acquaintance with tropical diseases. I am well aware of the technical and political problems which face Third World countries as they try to improve their standards of health.

My wife lived in Kenya, while a student at the University of Nairobi, in the early 1970's and has long been interested in returning to East Africa.
