BOOKS FOR THE SOC AND INSAS

Apropos our discussion last week with Reg September, who is responsible for the setting up of the INSTITUTE OF SOUTH AFRICAN STUDIES (INSAS) alongside the STUDENT ORIENTATION CENTRE (SOC) at the ANC Development Centre, Dakawa, I am writing to confirm the arrangement for acquiring library books for both the SOC and INSAS.

Books lists will be sent to NAT Perez of the ANC London Education Committee. He will channel the orders to Journeyman Press, which will process the orders and have the consignments airfreighted to Dar Es Salaam. Journeyman Press will invoice the FINNISH LIBRARY ASSOCIATION (FLA) for payment. FLA, the Department of Education and Reg September will be sent a statement of account by Nat Perez every Six months, beginning in June 1989.


As the Project Leader/Administrator of the FINNIDA ASSISTED FLA Project I hope you will be able to contact Nat Perez and Journeyman Press, as soon as possible. Furthermore, kindly liaise with the Head of the SOC and the Coordinator of INSAS (Quintin Magula) about the books they require (although, much of the initial order for the INAS Library will originate in London), the classification of books when they arrive, etc.

Clearing the books at the Airport will also require your assistance. We hope you will be able to enlist the assistance of either the ANC Mission, or NPA or TCRS.

I shall inform Nat Perez and Journeyman Press that you will be the main contact person in Tanzania. However, it will be necessary to keep the Regional Treasurer and other relevant officials briefed.

Your Visit to Lusaka last week was extremely useful and I wish to extend the gratitude of the Department for the work you accomplished in Lusaka.
