Minutes of the last committee meeting held on the 4th November 1982.

Present all members except comrade Jane.

Minutes of the last committee meeting were read and adopted as a correct record.

Matters arising:

It was again decided on the question of a relief committee that it have to be dealt with at the Commissariat level. And that comrade Jane as our commissar and our representative to the RFC was supposed to have raised the matter at the RFC meeting.

Correspondence

A letter from the RFC was read complaining about the attendance of our representative.

It was then decided that a letter be written to the RPG apologising on the matter.

The two letters from HQ were read, one was about the material sent to us by the "/8 -secretariat, and the other was informing us about the OXFAM, whom they had not yet contacted them but promised to inform us of the result in due course.

About the Flag comrade Florence informed the meeting that it was a mistake the W/Secretariat was making to say that they gave her a Flag for our unit. The Committee decided that a letter be written to correct this. She also promised that she will be going to HQ and will talk with them about this matter.

On the question of photos for August 9th, comrade chair informed the meeting that the money was collected from the office but seemingly the people dealing with this question are not available whenever they are needed. Comrade Prieiller promised to help us in getting back our photos.

On the question of children hand work comrade chair further informed the meeting about the 2 circulars which came from HQ asking all depts responsible for the Pioneers to help the children in producing art and handwork. It was further reported that already their drawings were sent and the other material will follow soon.

Report back by the 3 Delegation:

A brief report was given by comrade Florence on behalf of the 3 comrades who left for Dar for Child development course. Firstly she reported that comrade Getrude Shope said they should not write a report not our region since this report will be circulated to all the regions, and this will come from the HQ. She informed us that the course was based on the role played by Mothers and the International community. And that there was a shortage of teachers and nurses and that manpower was still a problem which needed to be solved. An inspiring thing was that, the mothers were taught to live together on communal basis, and that this helped a lot to mothers who wish to go back to school and had to leave their children behind. That this was not a simple thing, but had to be stressed to mothers leaving there. She further informed the meeting that Mrs Fontene from UNESCO was presented by with a beaded necklace on their last day. And she was the one who made the vote of thanks on behalf of the women.

Comrade Chair informed the meeting about the visit by Malome to the Pioneers. And that he gave the Children the bus as was promised by the TG on June the 1st. It was reported that the children were happy about the buse and when seing it they started shouting slogans and sang revolutionary songs with great joy. The meeting decided that a letter'ue written to the TG thanking him for sending the bus for our children.

On the question of a driver comrade chair said that Malone said that we should have our own dtiver and suggested that we should oak comrade Isabella - who reeponde positively and was prepared to do the work.

Comrade Chair furher informed the meeting about a report from comrade Dorris and said that the report will be read in tour next meeting.
