I wish to refer you to our letter (undated) informing you that we had written to the governments of Trinidad and Tobago, Antigua, St. Vincent and Dominica, as a result of the telex you sent us on 6 June 1986. The impression we got from your telex was that these governments had already agreed to pledge a certain amount of money to the ANC. We were, therefore, surprised and disappointed to receive a letter from the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of St. Vincent and the Grenadines, informing us that they were unable to make any financial contribution. A copy of this letter is enclosed for your information. Kindly send us a report of your discussions with the four governments, so that we are in a better position to understand why our request to the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines was turned down. I also think that in future it would be advisable for you to send us such reports before we make requests for financial contributions. As yet we have not received any response from the other three governments. If you have not already done so, please follow up our request with them. We hope that you will have more success with these governments. We hope to hear from you in the near future.
