MUKHUBA Nelson

Born 1925 Tshakhuma, Venda.

Died 1987 Tshakhuma, Venda.

A self-taught sculptor of figures, heads, animals and abstracts. Worked in wood and paint. From 1956 ceramic figures and relief sculptures.

Profile A member of Bozz Art. 1980 three of his sculptures were reproduced on an issue of Venda stamps. 1986 one of six artists chosen for a documentary film made on Venda artists. 1947-58 involved in various marabi music bands, cutting records with "The Zoutpansberg Merry Makers", "Nelson and the Phiri Boys" and "The Music Men". From 1977 a member of the Venda Traditional Dance Group. During the 1980s initiated and trained dancers and singers for the "Maholombe a Mutanda Bin Yuka" Group. 1945-58 lived in Sophiatown, thereafter in Tshakhuma.

Exhibitions Participated in several group exhibitions from 1970 in Venda, five in Johannesburg, one in Durban, one in Cape Town and two in West Germany; 1985 Tributaries, touring SA and West Germany; 1986 Bozz Art Foundation Exhibition, touring Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban, with Dr Phatuma Seoka (qv), Heindrick Nekhofhe (qv) and Jackson Hlungwani (qv); 1987 Johannesburg Art Gallery, Vita Art Now.

Represented Africana Museum, Johannesburg; Durban Art Gallery; SA National Gallery, Cape Town; University of South Africa; University of the Witwatersrand.
