
RE: ANC PROGRAMME PROPOSAL 1987/1991

This is to report that the ANC Programme Proposal for 1987 to 1991 has now been submitted, through the post, to the Senior Area Officer at UNDP Headquarters, New York. Copies to the UNDP Resident Representative in Dar-es-Salaam will be hand carried by me, this weekend.

It is expected that Mr. Kotta will meet us in Geneva to finalise the document before it is submitted to their experts.

For me though, I need to underline the importance of making appropriate arrangements for implementation by the Movement. Concretely, the Department of Manpower Development and the National Scholarship Committee have to be directed at this early stage to identify candidates and make applications for admission to relevant institutions of training in Africa. We need to be a bit more purposeful in our training. There has been a tendency to mount programmes just because offers have been made. We have to change. We are, after all, a government-in-waiting.
