NATURE OF BENEFITS

The NCCRAEhier policy on educational contributions towards the needs of returning children is based on individual need and does not represent a general stander grant. e policy therefore stipulates as follova:

- a) up to Rand 1,400 for-one primary school year per child
 - b) up to Rand 1.800 for one secondary school year per child
- This is a one time assistance. The applicants should produce a letter of eferel originating only from NCCR.

COUNSELLING

will be consolidated within the NCCR PWV regional counselling system thus ensuring a well coordinated programme.

CRITERIA

Assistance shall be pd extended to all returning exilesfchildren) qualifying under the NCCRM project eub-agreement. Assistance will be extended irrespective of political and other affiliation.
