Housing Committee meeting held in the Director's Office 29/11/83.

Cds Present: Director, Jimmy, Blackman, Farida, Kentrige and Enes.
Apologies: Cde Emily.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted. The first report came from Tabera, comrade Blackman reported that their Committee is facing problems due to the unco-operative attitude shown by Cde Christina. Cde Arthur advised the comrades in Tabera to have ^{ELECTIONS} elections for the new Committee. He went on by saying two members from the Charlottes and two from the Youth Center should be Co-operated into that Committee. On the case of T.B. in Tabera Cde Enes has to see the Head of the Clinic on this matter.

Copenhagen

The Residencial Committee in this Area is composed of Cde Farida, Gea, Spencer, Busi and Kays. The Housing Committee advised Cde Farida to talk to the comrades staying in Copenhagen not to water their gardens during the day. Two places were cited these were Cde Babu's and Kays and Farida was to go and talk to them about the water problem up at the school.

Ilala

Cde Kentridge reported that the problem of the Refridgerator in Ilala has resulted in cases of theft. Cde Enes said Kentridge should see Cde Mabaruti on the question of getting another big fridge for Ilala. Cde Arthur said the Committee should deal with these comrades who are involved in stealing if they fail to deal with such cases they refer them to his Office. ^{SHOULD}

School

Water is still a problem up at the school. Cde Jimmy said they are still facing difficulties with mattresses they have asked the Treasury to buy some for school. This was reported a month ago but up till now there is no green light from the Treasury. This must be treated as an urgent matter as students from Dakawa will be joining the

School in January. Some of the demitories have been attacked by bed-bucks. Cde Swazi has promised to send a team from Agric. for fumigation. A Committee was formed and is composed of Cde Wilmar Chair, Lulama Secretary, Sethunya Commissar and Cde David, Cde Jimmy still remains the member of the Committee.

C Crowding has been reported in Unit One Block Three. Cde Enos was asked to go and see Cde Willem on the possibilities of using Block Two. Cde Arthur has to see the Vice Principal about Ma-Meisy's accommodation as the Committee suggested that she can use the room presently used by Student Council.

Maintenance Team

Cde Enos reported that the Team has been doing a fine job. Kihonda has been painted and J.B. Marks has been renovated. Several houses has been fixed with gauze-wire in Ilala, and some of the beds which were without straps in the Youth Center Painting has been going on; two houses were painted in Unit Two and Two in Unit One. The Tanzanians working with the Team are on leave and they'll be back on the 21st of December.

Official opening of the School

Residencial Committees have to Co-ordinate with the Preparatory Committee and Jorgen on Landscaping for their Areas. The Committees must organise Letsima's for cleaning their surroundings.

Waiting List

The waiting list for the Complex stands at 24 and some of the cases in the list must be given first preference. The Director proposed that the Complex Commissar has to move to Copenhagen when Kays leaves.

General Buisness

Cde Blackman reported that Kasten's car came from Town in the early hours of the morning on the 27th Nov 83. Kasten took some girls to Tabera and this has disturbed the guarding system. The Complex Commissar has to organize a meeting with the Volunteers in order to explain to them the rules and regulations of the Complex.

The meeting was adjourned at 18: 20 hours.
