Re: A.N.C. (SA) and G. Chaane & Co.
Instructions to other Legal Practitioners

I refer to the above matter and to my separate discussions with Cdes Zola Skweyiya and P. Maduna regarding same. We seem to be agreed on principle that the system of payment relating to lawyers instructed by me on your behalf and presently in force is unsatisfactory from my point of view. It is, to say the least, embarrassing for me to receive constant reminders particularly from Rahim Khan and Doreen Khama about the non-payment of their fees.

I Propose the following:-

That you open an account in the U.K. or wherever it is convenient for you and which account I can operate with your strict supervision, i.e.

- a) you keep the cheque book with you and I only sign the cheques when the amount has been approved. I can then forward the cheque to the recipient;
- b) you will have the power to ask for any statements direct from the bank relating to the account and thus you can audit the account.

As indicated to both Cdes, I prefer not to handle any monies, if I can help it, but if the system works, it will cut out my Professional embarrassment.
