During our last trip to Africa, we received the upsetting news that bales of uniform material intended for SOMAFCO ended up not doing what it was painstakingly solicited for.

Instead, it was distributed generously to Comrades in

East Ahrica.

From the time we ware askedh to find a donor to the time of actually getting ans, we made many vain attempts to interest friends on the question of a schaol unifurm. Scandinavians are generally opposed to the very notion of a school uniform as they consider it a form af rsgimantation. Hence, we were quite relieved when the Finnish Africa Committee made this first centributian to us. This, after two and a half years of searching.

Us parsanally had to make sure that the material was of the quality needing very little care. Each student was to hava a sat a? three unifarma per week with an estimated 300 students, over a three year period. There was navy creasasrasiatant Fabric for pants and tunics; white cotton Fabric far shirts. All possible accessories were considered and purchased, 1.3. buttons, Zippers, binding, inter and inner facing material, scissors. hooks, press and eyes. The Bill af Lading was sent early enough for anyone rsceiving the shipment to have had time to 0002/

consult in case of uncertainty as ta the end use of the goods. The very nature of the content with such accessories should have alerted anyene of the special nature of the shipment. You can therefore understand our anger when suits, costumes etc became the final product. To boot, we learned with added disgust that same of the Fabric was sold to Tanzaniahs. Morse still is our suspicion that ha acknowledgement was ever made to the donor otherwise we usuld have received a copy. Besides, it would have been narmal to indicate of what particular value the gift was - in which case thn ward "unitarn" usuld have suggested itself.

He are eager for an explanation as ta how such a grass misuse occured. When the donors realise the vimilation of their wishes to outfit the pupils in accordance with ANC stipulations, us will look like an organisation that solicits under false pretax. Our raflactian leads us to the conclusion that those respansible should be the ones who should hunt for replacement. Pardon the anger but the entire episode dues nut amuse. Amandla.
