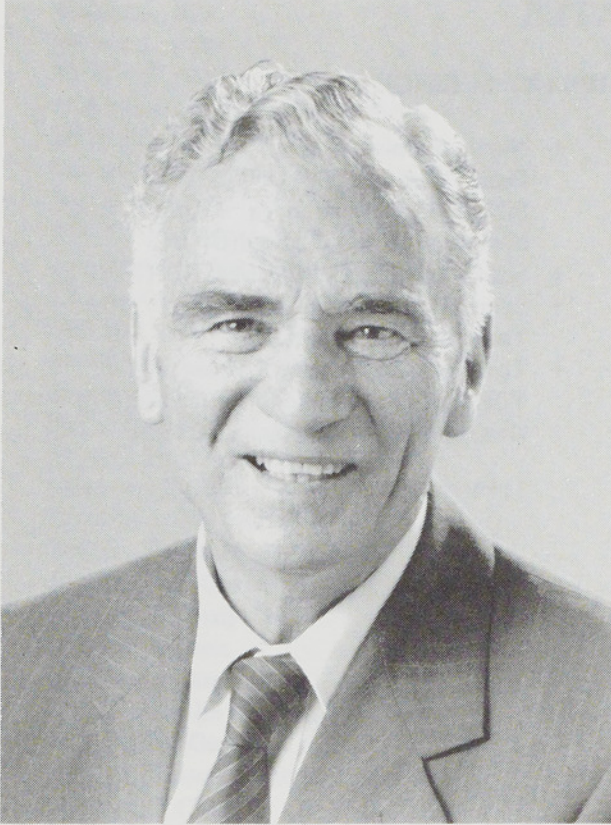

CONFERMENT OF THE DEGREE OF
DOCTOR OF LITERATURE
honoris causa UPON
GERHARDUS CORNELIS OOSTHUIZEN

Gerhardus Oosthuizen was born in 1922 in the Eastern Cape and completed his schooling at Kirkwood High School. He took his first degree, a B.A., at the University of Stellenbosch in 1941. In the next seventeen years he became the recipient of many other degrees: Master of Theology from Stellenbosch, M.A. and D.Phil in Philosophy from UNISA, Doctor of Theology from the Free University of Amsterdam and Master of Sacred Theology from the Union Theological Seminary in New York.

In the meantime he had spent two years at the end of the Second World War as a chaplain in the South African Army, and he had worked as a DRC Minister in Bulawayo and in Queenstown.

In 1959 he joined the staff of the University of Fort Hare, first as a senior lecturer, then as a professor. From 1969 till 1984 he was at the University of Durban-Westville, for most of that time holding the inaugural chair of the Science of Religion. Since 1984 he has been the Director of NERMIC, a research unit for Indigenous/Independent Churches and New Religious Movements, the unit is funded by the HSRC and administered by the University of Zululand.

Professor Oosthuizen has published and edited books in a wide variety of fields - medical ethics, the sociology of religion, tertiary education - but his primary achievement is in the advancement of the relatively new discipline of the study of religions. He has been described as the doyen of Religious Studies scholars in South Africa, and his NERMIC research unit has recently been adjudged 'one of the two most important centres in the world for its type of work'. Some of his most valuable research has been focused on the new African religious movements of Southern Africa which are such a remarkable and important feature of our social history.

The University of Natal honours Professor Oosthuizen for his original, imaginative and scholarly explorations in this highly significant field of study and understanding.
